

Dear Pool Owner,

Welcome to your new pool or pool finish. Your help is needed in two categories of care to help manage your new pool water properly. The first category is the first 30 days while your pool coating is curing underwater, and the second is after 30 days. If you have a fiberglass pool or a vinyl liner pool, then the initial "stabilization" period is only 10 days, rather than 30 days.

It is very important that these recommendations be followed to assure a successful pool start-up and to help prevent surface staining & discoloration; especially in darker colored pools, where any type of contrast is more pronounced. Jack's Magic **the magenta stuff™** was added to your pool for stain prevention. **the magenta stuff™** allows your pool filter to trap dissolved metals and minerals from your pool water and help keep calcium from depositing on your pool coating. **the magenta stuff™** will also reduce existing phosphates. For superior filtration, **the filter fiber stuff™** can be added to the filter (according to directions on package) to achieve the most efficient filtering of any contaminants. As it does its job, **the magenta stuff™** becomes depleted. **the magenta stuff™** should be added weekly at a rate of 6-8 ounces per 15,000 gallons of water. In addition, the pool needs to be brushed as often as possible during the first 30 days and as needed after 30 days.

The pH and alkalinity MUST be constantly adjusted downward during the first 30 days (to lower the pH to 7.2 and the alkalinity to 80 or below). You may need to add "pool acid" to your new pool 3-4 times per week for the first 15 days, and 2-3 times per week the second 15 days to maintain this alkalinity and pH reading. Adding this acid will lower both the pH and alkalinity.

If there is a salt/chlorine generator on the pool it should be activated at the 30 day point of the start-up. Continue using **the magenta stuff**[™] at a rate of 6-8 ounces per 15,000 gallons of pool water. **the magenta stuff**[™] will actively reduce scaling and fouling of salt generator cells. Consult with your swimming pool professional for the product that's best for your pool.

If there is an ionization system on the pool it should be activated at the 2-week point of the start-up. At this time you should begin to use **the ionizer stuff**[®].

After 30 days, continue adding 6-8 ounces of **the magenta stuff**[™] per 15,000 gallons of water, per week, to your pool. Other pool water parameters, should be checked and adjusted (to normal pool water levels) on a regular basis as needed. Please note: your pool will only use **the magenta stuff** as needed. The amount added to your pool only replaces the amount which was depleted while trapping metals/minerals in your filter. Failure to remove these metals can and will cause pool surface staining.
